**TOWN MARSHAL REPORT:** This past Saturday, a neighbor's home was burglarized between 4-6 pm. Articles stolen include jewelry, full drawers from a chest, an X-Box, and three computers. The intruders attempted to steal a big screen TV, so we know a vehicle was involved. Anyone who noticed anything unusual on 106<sup>th</sup> or upper 29<sup>th</sup> during this time should notify Town Marshal Walter Scott, Deputy Marshal Scott Harpster, or King County Sheriff.

Please pay close attention to vehicles slowly cruising the area. If you see an unknown vehicle doing this, please write down the license number and send it to Mr. Scott or Mr. Harpster. Also, beware of door-to-door solicitors that do not have, or will not show ID. Burglars sometimes use this approach to canvas the area, trying doors when no one answers, and often operate in pairs so there is a "look out." Thank you. – Town Marshal Scott

**COUNCIL BUSINESS:** At the February 8, 2011 meeting, the Council:

- Passed Ordinance No. 381 amending the Town's Traffic Ordinance to include the 25-mph speed limit on 108<sup>th</sup> Ave SE and to eliminate sections of the Model Traffic Ordinance that does not apply to Beaux Arts.
- Discussed the next steps to take on the 108<sup>th</sup> Ave SE right-of-way-improvement project. Council members Sharp and Stowe will put together a Scope of Work for the project and will collect proposals for completing the design work.
- Discussed the development of a Commercial Right-of-Way Use ordinance to protect the paved and unpaved portions of the Town's ROWs from damage caused by trucks with very large loads that may use our streets (but are not associated with a permitted building project).
- Continued discussions about minor changes to the ordinance creating the office of Hearing Examiner and about changes to ancillary ordinances (the Zoning Code, Tree Code, and the Regulatory Reform Code) that are affected by this change. The Planning Commission expected to hold a public hearing on changes to the Zoning and Tree Codes in late February, and the Council anticipates being able to take action on all four ordinances at their March meeting.

**SR 520 BRIDGE ELECTRONIC TOLL PASSES NOW AVAILABLE! Drivers eligible for \$10 in free tolls if they sign up before April 15<sup>th</sup>!** Drivers on the SR 520 Bridge can now sign up for *Good To Go!*, Washington State's all-electronic toll collection system that allows drivers to pay tolls without stopping at a tollbooth. Tolling is scheduled to begin this spring. As a special incentive for those establishing an account early, you can *receive \$10 in free tolls* on SR 520 by signing up for a *Good To Go!* Pass and activating it *before April 15, 2011*. **Funding Your *Good To Go!* Account:** When setting up your *Good To Go!* account, you will need to deposit a minimum of \$30 to get started. Once established, every time you drive through a tolling facility, the toll amount will be deducted automatically from your prepaid account. To make sure your *Good to Go!* account is never overdrawn, it is easy to set up auto-charge so that your bank account or credit card is automatically charged with a preset amount when your account balance gets low. You will receive a monthly email with a link to your account statement, and can check your recent account activity online or by phone at any time. With auto-charge, you're always *Good To Go!*
