COUNCIL BUSINESS: At the March 13, 2012 meeting, the Council:

- Continued their review of the draft Shoreline Master Program (SMP) as written by the Planning Commission to meet the mandates set forth by state statute while waiting for feedback from the Department of Ecology's (DOE) informal non-binding review. Town Planner Mona Green attended to answer the Council's questions about the entire plan, including the portions mandated by state statute and the portions added by the Planning Commission to tailor the plan to the needs of Beaux Arts. The Council will continue their review of the plan at the April 3, 2012 Council meeting to become familiar with the plan as they wait for Ecology to complete the informal review and provide feedback.

A copy of the current draft is available on the Town's website at http://www.beauxarts-wa.gov/whats_new.htm. Interested residents should review the document online and then attend the upcoming Council meeting to hear more details and ask questions.

After DOE's feedback is received, the Council will schedule at least one public hearing to give residents an opportunity for formal input about the draft SMP prior to its adoption.

NEXT COUNCIL MEETING: The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held at **7:00pm on Tuesday, April 3, 2012** at Matt Leber's house. Please note that this is one week EARLIER than the Council's regular meeting date so that the entire Council is available to continue participating in the SMP discussion.
