

**TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS VILLAGE
ORDINANCE NO. 242**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS VILLAGE, WASHINGTON,
ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN DATED DECEMBER 1994.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Beaux Arts Village has thoroughly studied the Comprehensive Plan dated December 1994, which regulates the use and development of property within the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the aforementioned version of the Comprehensive Plan has been reviewed in public hearings held by both the Planning Commission and the Town Council of the Town; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS VILLAGE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town Council of the Town of Beaux Arts Village adopts the Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Beaux Arts Village dated December 1994.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its passage, posting, and publication.

Section 3. State Environmental Policy Act. This ordinance does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement is not required. This decision was made after the review of a completed environmental check list, which is on file with the Deputy Town Clerk, along with a Determination of Nonsignificance form.
