

**TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS VILLAGE  
ORDINANCE NO. 381**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS VILLAGE REGULATING  
MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION, DEFINING  
OFFENSES AND PENALTIES AND POWERS OF OFFICERS, ADOPTING THE  
WASHINGTON MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AND REPEALING  
ORDINANCE NOS. 35, 153, 156, 240 AND 273.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BEAUX ARTS  
VILLAGE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Speed Limits.**

1.1. It shall be unlawful to operate any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of ten miles per hour within the confines of the Town, except as hereinafter provided.

1.2. It shall be unlawful to operate any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty miles per hour on any of the following streets:

1.2.1. Upon 104th Avenue SE, between the north boundary of the Town and SE 28th Street.

1.2.2. Upon SE 28th Street, between 104th Avenue SE and 105th Avenue SE.

1.2.3. Upon 105th Avenue SE, between SE 28th Street and SE 30th Street.

1.3. It shall be unlawful to operate any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty-five miles per hour on 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE, between the north boundary of the Town and SE 30<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Section 2. Adoption of Statutes by reference.**

2.1. Except as provided herein, the Washington Model Traffic Ordinance (MTO), Ch. 308-330 WAC, as herein modified and amended, is hereby adopted by reference as the traffic ordinance of the Town of Beaux Arts Village as though set forth in full herein and shall be known as the Town Traffic Ordinance.

2.2. The following sections of the Washington MTO are not adopted and are hereby excluded from this ordinance:

2.2.1. WAC 308-330-210 and 308-330-215 providing for a traffic division.

2.2.2. WAC 308-330-230 through 308-330-245 delegating duties to the traffic division.

2.2.3. WAC 308-330-260 through 308-330-275 establishing the office of traffic engineer and a traffic safety commission.

2.2.4. WAC 308-330-500 through 308-330-540 requiring licensing of bicycles.

**Section 3. Enforcement.** Any peace officer of the Town, including members of the King County Sheriff’s Office, is hereby empowered to issue a citation to or to arrest any person for a violation of this ordinance.

**Section 4. Repealer.** The following ordinances are hereby repealed:

- 4.1. Ordinance No. 35, passed by the Council on February 4, 1964.
- 4.2. Ordinance No. 153, passed by the Council on November 11, 1980.
- 4.3. Ordinance No. 156, passed by the Council on January 31, 1981.
- 4.4. Ordinance No. 240, passed by the Council on June 14, 1994.
- 4.5. Ordinance No. 273, passed by the Council on August 26, 1997.

**Section 5. Validity.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, paragraph, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, paragraphs, clauses, or phrases subsequently may be found by competent authority to be unconstitutional or invalid.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its passage and publication.
